

The Department of Primary Health Care is located in the west of central Oxford on Hythe Bridge Street, 5 minutes from Oxford Train Station. We occupy the second floor of the black building between the Saïd Business School and the bridge over the canal.

On arrival please go to the main entrance of our building and advise the receptionist you are visiting the Department of Primary Health Care. You will then be directed to the second floor. In the event that a receptionist is not available, please ring the bell as indicated on the desk.

How to find us

From the town centre at Carfax, walk north up Cornmarket Street until you reach George Street. Turn left into George Street and continue, keeping on the right-hand side. At the end of George Street, cross the road onto Hythe Bridge Street at the traffic lights, keeping to the right-hand side. Cross over the bridge and the building is a few metres along on the right.

Directions by car

From the A34 ring road come off at the Botley Interchange and follow the A420, which becomes the Botley Road leading into central Oxford. Go straight ahead through all traffic lights, past the railway station on your left and continue straight onto Hythe Bridge Street.

Parking

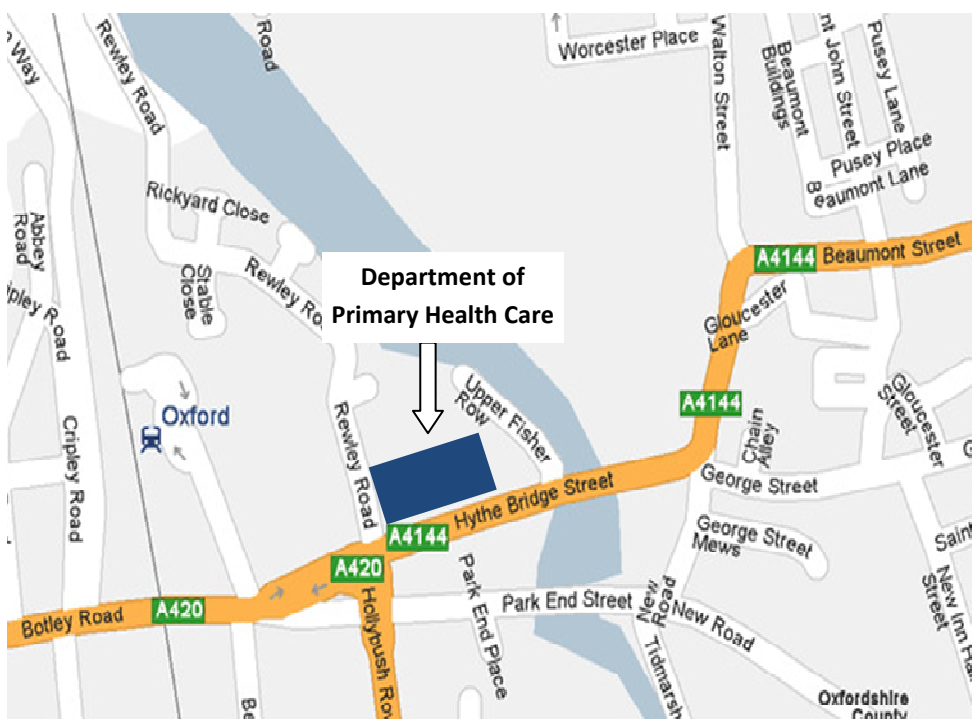
The nearest pay and display car parks are situated on Worcester Street and at Gloucester Green. There is also short and long term parking opposite the Train Station which is a 2 minute walk to our office. Seacourt Park & Ride on Botley Road is approximately a 20 minute walk from Hythe Bridge Street.

By train

The office is a 2 minute walk from the train station. Turn right when you exit the main station door then walk to the main road. Turn left past the Saïd Business School and continue up to Hythe Bridge Street.

By Bus/Coach

The X90 and Oxford tube from London, and all coaches from the airports stop at Gloucester Green Coach Station, which is a 5 minute walk from Hythe Bridge Street. Come out of the Coach Station on George Street and cross the traffic lights onto Hythe Bridge Street.
